Dear Supervisor Holland:

Approximately 20% of Florida's citizens have some type of disability. Many of these people vote, and most have friends and family who vote. As you are aware, state and federal laws guarantee the right to accessible voting for individuals with disabilities. Citizens with disabilities should also have full access to all aspects of civic participation.

The Advocacy Center for Persons with Disabilities, Inc. has embarked on the Voter Independence Project (VIP) to ensure that persons with disabilities have the opportunity to exercise their right to independently vote in 2008 in accordance with the Help America Vote Act (HAVA) and other laws. As a component of the VIP, the Advocacy Center surveyed 180 early voting sites in 49 of the 67 counties.

Congratulations! Our staff surveyed the early voting locations in Duval County and found them to be in compliance with accessibility standards within the scope of the survey. We appreciate your county's efforts ensuring that persons with disabilities can access an early voting location in your county in the same manner persons without disabilities can access it.
