Voter Data & Maps

OVERVIEW

Effective January 2006, voter registration information can be made available to any citizen by a public records request. (FS 119, Public Record Laws)

SELECTION CRITERIA

Voter records may be selected based upon precinct, district, voted elections or entire county. Demographics such a sex, race, age, party affiliation and voter history can be used to pull specialized reports.

PRINTED LISTS

Printed lists will contain a voter's name and voter id number, address, precinct, party, sex, date of birth, registration date. The lists can be arranged in street order, name order, or precinct order. The first 5 pages are free on a small copy job. The first 20 are free on a large copy job (over 100). Additional pages are .15 cents per page. Two-sided copies .20 each.

ELECTRONIC FILES

Voter registration data is extracted from the data base and sent via email. There is no charge for this. A record layout document is included with the zipped file and instructions for viewing the data are contained in the email. Software such as WinZip and MS Excel are needed to open the text files (CSV format).

MAILING LABELS

Voter labels may be printed using specific selection criteria. (Cost: .50 cents per page of 20 labels)

MAPS

Black & white, 8 1/2 x 11 size maps are 15 cents per page (first 5 are free). B/W maps 11 x 17 are \$1.00 Color maps 11 x 17 are \$2.00. Precinct maps are available for download at the Supervisor of Elections web site. Black & white wall size maps are \$15.00. Full color large maps are \$25.00. Payment is to be made in full before printing.

Special order map costs will be determined by materials needed and extra time required to prepare the request.
