**Recounts for the race of Mayor of Atlantic Beach and Bartram Springs  
Community Development District Seat 2 Supervisor are complete**

**JACKSONVILLE** – The Duval County Canvassing Board completed the recounts for the November 2022 General Election of the Atlantic Beach Mayoral Race and the Bartram Springs CDD, Seat 2 race on November 15, 2022.

The initial results of the Atlantic Beach race yielded a ten-vote difference between the two leading candidates. The results of the race for the Mayor of Atlantic Beach based on the machine recount indicated a ten-vote margin between the two candidates. Because the results were within one-quarter of one percent, a manual recount was conducted of the undervotes and no additional votes for either candidate were identified.

The initial results for the Bartram Springs CDD, Seat 2 race yielded a four-vote difference between the two candidates. Following the machine recount, a five-vote margin was determined with the same candidate in the lead. The five-vote margin prevented the need for a manual recount because the margin was greater than one-quarter of one percent of the total vote.

Based on the completion of the recount, the Duval County Canvassing Board has completed the second unofficial results. Military Overseas Ballots have until 5 p.m. on Friday, November 18, 2022, to return their ballots, at which time, the Canvassing Board can certify the final results of the election.
