Recent legislative changes to Florida Law now require that our office verify one of the following identifiers when a voter updates their record with this office or requests a Vote-by-Mail ballot:

- Florida driver license number/ Florida ID card number
- The last four digits of the Social Security number

We strive to maintain up-to-date voter records. During a recent audit, it was determined that around 34,000 Duval County registered voters did not have this information on file.

We recently sent a mailer to these voters to give them the opportunity to update their record. This will allow them to update their address or request vote by mail ballots online or over the phone.

For the voter's convenience, the mailer included a voter registration application and a postage-paid envelope. The voter can simply complete the application with the required information and return the application to our office.
